- Emphasis on nontraditional study abroad destinations
- Students studying critical languages are eligible for an additional \$3,000



- **48%** of all Gilman Scholars have been first generation college students.
- **55%** of Gilman Scholars from academic year 2009-10 represented ethnic minority groups.

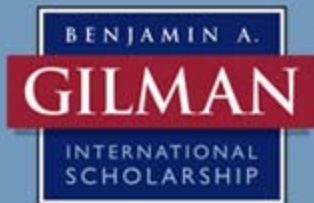

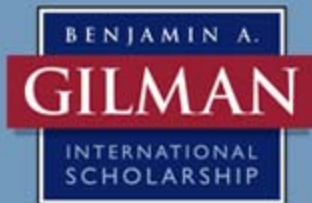
